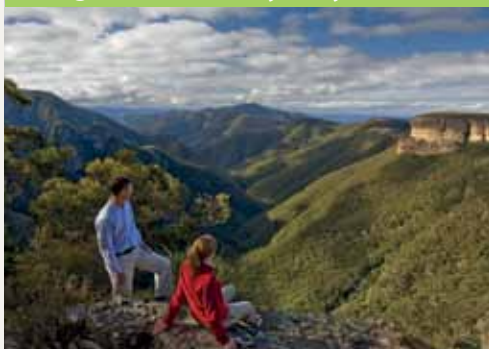

5 Day Sunlover Blue Mountains and Hunter Valley Sydney to Sydney

Sample fine wines, savour local delicacies and take in the breathtaking views as you tour the highlights of Sydney's surrounds.

Day 1: Sydney to Blue Mountains (100km)

Head west for the Blue Mountains, stopping at Echo Point for the best views of the Jamison Valley and magnificent Three Sisters rock formation. Visit spectacular Wentworth Falls and enjoy a trip on the scenic railway or cableway, or tour Jenolan Caves (all at own expense). Overnight at Leisure Inn Spires, Leura.

Day 2: Blue Mountains to Hunter Valley (230km)

If you wish, spend some more time exploring the Blue Mountains before departing for the Hunter Valley. Travel

north through the towns of Mt Victoria and Bilpin as well as Wollemi National Park to reach the Hunter Valley. Stay the next two nights at Hunter Resort, Pokolbin.

Day 3: Hunter Valley

A full day to explore the wineries and gourmet delights of the Hunter Valley. There are wineries in abundance, local artisans and beautiful gardens. Tonight dine in one of the many gourmet restaurants in the area.

Day 4: Hunter Valley to Port Stephens (101km)

5 Day Sunlover Wollongong and Beyond Sydney to Wollongong

Travel via the amazing Grand Pacific Drive to Wollongong. This itinerary provides a selection of day trips for you to experience from Wollongong.

Day 1: Sydney to Wollongong (81km)

Head south into the Royal National Park and enjoy coastal rainforests and open plains. Admire the coastal views at Otford and Bald Hill lookouts. Drive through spectacular coastal villages and traverse the Sea Cliff Bridge between Coalcliff and Clifton. Continue along the Grand Pacific Drive and enjoy the stunning coastal views en route to Wollongong, a lively city with great beaches, shopping, restaurants, art galleries and more. Stay the next four nights at Ibis Wollongong.

Day 2: Wollongong

Enjoy the day exploring at your own pace. Enjoy the fantastic views of Wollongong and Illawarra from the Mt Keira lookout. Visit the largest Buddhist Temple in the southern hemisphere, Nan Tien Temple or stop at Five Islands Brewery.

Day 3: Wollongong to Shellharbour (30km one way)

On your way to Shellharbour, take a stroll along the shores of Lake Illawarra or discover the lake by canoe. Shellharbour boasts the region's only marine aquatic reserve; Bushrangers Bay at Bass Point. Take a relaxing walk through Shellharbour village then visit Killalea State Park.

Day 4: Wollongong to Kiama (38km one way)

Head to Kiama and Cliff Drive to view the Cathedral Rocks and the Blowhole. Visit Minnamurra Rainforest before heading through Jamberoo Mountain Road to see native wildlife and Carrington Falls. Visit the Illawarra Fly Tree Top Walk (own expense) before heading to Moss Vale.

Day 5: Wollongong to Southern Highlands (70km one way)

Drive through Macquarie Pass, alternatively take Tourist Drive 9 via Jamberoo Mountain Road to see native wildlife and Carrington Falls. Visit the Illawarra Fly Tree Top Walk (own expense) before heading to Moss Vale.

The car is booked until the following day and should be dropped off in Sydney by the same time it was picked up on Day 1 to avoid any additional charges.

6 Day Sunlover Pacific Coast Explorer Sydney to Brisbane

Bay, which attracts surfers from near and far. Cape Byron's northerly aspect makes it one of the best beaches for surfing on the East Coast of Australia. Cape Byron is the most easterly point on the Australian coast. Stay two nights at Larder Byron Resort.

Day 5: Byron Bay

Today is free to spend at your leisure. Enjoy the restaurants and cafés, take a kayaking tour, hot air balloon ride (all own expense) or simply relax on the beach.

Day 6: Byron Bay to Brisbane (166-197km)

For early risers, it's well worth a trip to the beach this morning to watch the sun rise over the Pacific Ocean. Depart Byron and travel north to Brunswick Heads. You can either continue along the coast via Pottsville Beach and Kingscliff and travel on to Brisbane via the Gold Coast, or travel inland to Murwillumbah. Continue on the Pacific Motorway for the short, direct route to Brisbane or travel via Burleigh Heads and Surfers Paradise. You can also discover the Gold Coast Hinterland, stopping at Lamington National Park, before arriving in Brisbane.

The car is booked until the following day and should be dropped off at the city or airport by the same time as it was picked up on Day 1 to avoid any additional charges.

Day 1: Sydney to Hunter Valley (216km)

Depart Sydney and travel north over the Harbour Bridge and on to the Pacific Highway. Travel via Gosford and Newcastle, stopping for a scenic walk along the foreshore. Continue on via Maitland and into the Hunter Valley. With wineries in abundance, take the opportunity to taste and purchase some of Australia's finest wines. Explore the art and gourmet delights that the Hunter Valley offers. Overnight at Hunter Resort.

Day 2: Hunter Valley to Port Stephens (101km)

Leave the Hunter Valley and travel northeast to Port Stephens. Known as the Blue Water Wonderland, Port Stephens is a natural bay two and a half times the size of Sydney Harbour and almost enclosed by two dormant volcanic headlands. There is fabulous seafood and over 26 golden sandy beaches to explore. Overnight

at All Seasons Salamander Shores.

Day 3: Port Stephens to Coffs Harbour (440km)

Depart Port Stephens and continue north to Bulahdelah, the entrance to the Myall Lakes National Park. Travel north along the Lakes Way, a scenic route through rainforest with spectacular views of the inland lakes and ocean beaches. Continue on to Coffs Harbour passing through the Manning Valley, Taree and Port Macquarie. Visit the Big Banana and learn of Coffs Harbour's banana industry. Overnight at Country Comfort Coffs Harbour.

Day 4: Coffs Harbour to Byron Bay (251km)

This northern stretch of New South Wales contains some of the most beautiful landscapes in Australia. From Coffs Harbour, the highway follows the coast to Woolgoolga and then turns inland towards Grafton, a graceful old country town on the banks of the mighty Clarence River. From Grafton travel to Woodburn and on to Ballina, then a further 38 kilometres to Byron

7 Day Sunlover Coastal Drive Sydney to Melbourne

Park where you can see a variety of native flora and fauna before arriving in the Gippsland region. Continue south via Yarram and Foster to reach the extraordinary Wilsons Promontory. It's riddled with masses of green forests and gardens, stunning mountains, rocky rivers, picturesque towns and long sandy beaches. Overnight at Comfort Inn Foster, Wilsons Promontory.

Day 6: Wilsons Promontory to Phillip Island (132km)

The drive from Wilsons Promontory to Phillip Island boasts stunning views of Victoria's southern coast. Discover the fascinating marine environment of Bunurong Marine and Coastal Park at Cape Paterson before arriving at Phillip Island, home to the Little penguins. The famous Penguin Parade occurs each evening at sunset and should not be missed (own expense). Overnight at All Seasons Eco Resort, Phillip Island.

Day 7: Phillip Island to Melbourne (140km)

It's only a two hour drive to Melbourne this morning and your journey will take you across the eastern suburbs of the city.

Day 1: Sydney to Jervis Bay (220km)

Travel south from Sydney through the Royal National Park and on to the Grand Pacific Drive with its spectacular coastal scenery. Travel across the impressive Sea Cliff Bridge and through rainforests and quaint coastal villages to reach Wollongong. Take the turn-off for Huskisson and Jervis Bay. Jervis Bay is well known for its resident dolphin population and nearby Hyams Beach renowned for its white sand. Overnight at Dolphin Sands Jervis Bay.

Day 2: Jervis Bay to Tilba Tilba (195km)

Driving south you'll have national park views to your west and stunning coastline views to your east. Continue along the coast through the towns of Batemans Bay and Narooma to reach Tilba Tilba and nearby Central Tilba, known for quality local arts and crafts. Overnight at Green Gables B&B, Tilba Tilba. (B)

Day 3: Tilba Tilba to Gipsy Point (190km)

Following the Princes Highway, drive through many towns and beautiful forests travelling along the amazing Sapphire Coast to the city of Merimbula. Continue through the Yambulla State Forest before crossing the border into Victoria and turning at Genoa to the beautiful Gipsy Point. Overnight at Gipsy Point Lakeside Apartments. (B)

Day 4: Gipsy Point to Lakes Entrance (207km)

Continue south via Cann River, visit the Cape Conran Coastal Park and the village of Marlo en route to the unique area of Lakes Entrance, with its rivers, lakes and lagoons joining 90 Mile Beach. Take a cruise or a sail around Australia's largest inland waterway. Explore the nearby village of Metung also located on the beautiful lakes. Overnight at Comfort Inn & Suites Emmanuel, Lakes Entrance. (B)

Day 5: Lakes Entrance to Wilsons Promontory (230km)
