Day 3: Kings Canyon to Uluru (318km)

Make an early start to complete the Rim Walk at Kings Canyon. Then travel to Yulara and see the world's greatest monolith, Uluru, and the domes of Kata Tjuta (Olgas). Check into your hotel and in the afternoon learn about the region's history, unique flora and fauna, how the earth created such remarkable landmarks and

Through the ancient heart of the Australian outback, travel by 4WD along the Red Centre Way as it navigates through Uluru-Kata Tjuta National Park, Kings Canyon, the West MacDonnell Ranges and Alice Springs.

Day 1: Alice Springs

Collect your vehicle and spend a full day exploring Alice Springs at leisure. Visit the Royal Flying Doctor Base, School of the Air or the Alice Springs Desert Park (own expense). Finish the day by taking a drive up Anzac Hill for views of the town at sunset. Overnight at Aurora Alice Springs.

Day 2: Alice Springs to Glen Helen (130km)

Depart Alice Springs and head west following the spectacular MacDonnell Ranges. Along the way visit

Simpson's Gap, Standley Chasm, Ellery Creek Gorge, Ormiston Gorge and Glen Helen Gorge. Overnight at Glen Helen Resort.

Day 3: Glen Helen to Kings Canyon (260km)

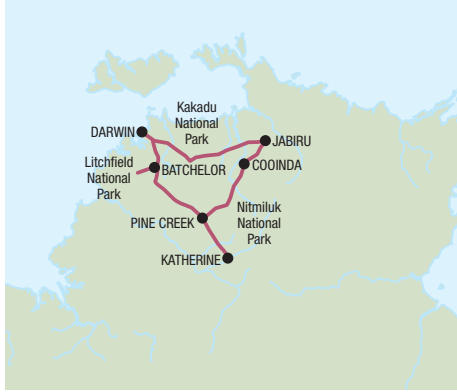
Experience some real four wheel driving today on the Mereenie Loop to Kings Canyon, an awe-inspiring sandstone chasm descending hundreds of metres below. Overnight at Kings Canyon Resort.

Day 4: Kings Canyon to Uluru (318km)

Start the morning early with a Kings Canyon Rim Walk before departing for Uluru and Ayers Rock Resort. Head to the 'sunset strip' to see a famous Uluru sunset. Overnight at Voyages Outback Pioneer Hotel, Ayers Rock Resort.

Day 2: Kakadu National Park

This morning you are booked on a Yellow Water Cruise from Cooiinda. The remainder of the day is at leisure. Take the opportunity to visit the Warradjan Aboriginal Cultural Centre, Nourlangie Rock and Ubirr Rock, to see some of the oldest and easily accessible Aboriginal rock art. Overnight at Aurora Kakadu.

Day 3: Kakadu National Park to Katherine (299km)

Depart early and travel towards Pine Creek and onto Katherine, making a leisure stop at the beautiful Edith Falls (Leliyn). Overnight at All Seasons Katherine.

Day 4: Katherine

This morning enjoy a spectacular two hour Katherine Gorge cruise. The best way to see the gorge is from the water. Perhaps visit Mataranka Thermal Pools this afternoon, or visit Katherine's iconic attractions. Overnight at All Seasons Katherine.

Day 5: Katherine to Litchfield National Park and Lake Bennett (370km)

Drive north and enjoy a full day exploring Litchfield National Park, the Top End's most accessible natural attraction offering swimming and spectacular waterfalls year round. Attractions include the Buley Rockhole, Wangi, Tolmer and Florence Falls. Overnight at scenic Lake Bennett Wilderness Resort.

Day 6: Litchfield National Park to Darwin (113km)

Enjoy more time in Litchfield National Park or relax at Lake Bennett before returning to Darwin. The car is booked until the following morning. Return the car by the same time it was picked up on Day 1 to avoid any additional charges.

Day 1: Uluru

On arrival at Ayers Rock collect your vehicle and check-in to your accommodation. This afternoon take a leisurely drive around 'The Rock' before heading to the 'sunset strip' to see a spectacular Uluru sunset. Overnight at Voyages Outback Pioneer Hotel, Ayers Rock Resort.

Day 2: Uluru

A full day to explore the region at leisure. Take a walk around the base of Uluru, enjoy a scenic flight or camel ride around the rock (own expense), or explore the spiritual domes of Kata Tjuta. Overnight at Voyages Outback Pioneer Hotel, Ayers Rock Resort.



Day 3: Uluru to Alice Springs (476km)

Depart for Alice Springs and travel to ERLDUNDA, passing the imposing Mount Conner. Spend the rest of the day exploring 'The Alice', the heart of the Outback. Overnight at Aurora Alice Springs.

Day 4: Alice Springs to Tennant Creek (530km)

Journey north towards the old mining town of Tennant Creek. Stop at the Devils Marbles, huge granite rock boulders that glow red in the light of early evening. Overnight at Bluestone Motor Inn.

Day 5: Tennant Creek to Katherine (663km)

An early start for the drive to Katherine. Stop en route at the famous outback pub at Daly Waters for a cold beer or relax at the thermal springs at Mataranka. Overnight at All Seasons Katherine.

Day 6: Katherine to Kakadu National Park (336km)

Spectacular Katherine Gorge is located 30 kilometres from Katherine. A two hour gorge cruise is booked this morning. Visit the Nitmiluk Visitor Centre before travelling towards historic Pine Creek and into the heart of Kakadu National Park. Overnight at Aurora Kakadu.

Day 7: Kakadu National Park

Cruise Yellow Water Billabong this morning and see an array of colourful bird life, wetlands and saltwater crocodiles. Continue to Ubirr and Nourlangie Rock, see some of the finest and most accessible Aboriginal rock art in the world. Overnight at Aurora Kakadu.

Day 8: Kakadu National Park to Darwin (242km)

Visit the Bowali and Window on the Wetlands Visitor Centres to learn more about Kakadu's landscapes and wildlife before returning to Darwin. The car is booked until the following morning. Return the car by the same time it was picked up on Day 1 to avoid any additional charges.
