### Day 2: Cooktown to Cairns

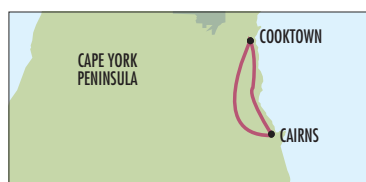

### Day 1: Cairns to Cooktown

Travel along the secondary gold route to the majestic Daintree Rainforest. Cross the Daintree River by vehicular ferry into the World Heritage rainforest. Journey to Alexander Range, Cape Tribulation, then onto the Bloomfield Track. Stop at Wujal Wujal Aboriginal community to stroll with the Walker Sisters to Bloomfield Falls, then a quick stop at the iconic Lions Den Hotel. On arrival at Mungumby Lodge its time for a refreshing swim. The next two nights are at Mungumby Lodge. (L)

### Day 2: Laura and Aboriginal Rock Art

Travel along the secondary gold route to the Palmer Goldfields, journey past termite mounds and sandstone escarpments into Quinkan country to the Quinkan Cultural Centre for an insight into the region's history and culture. On to Split Rock to view the Aboriginal rock art galleries within the sandstone escarpments. Stop at one of the Kings Plain billabongs and Little Annan Falls before heading back to the lodge. (BL)

### Day 3: Cooktown to Cairns

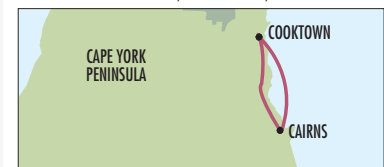
Discover the World Heritage rainforest then stop briefly at the Matilda Tank to view stinging trees, native ginger, Kauri trees, Acacia Cedars, Silky Oak and many other forest giants. Travel to the Lions Den Tin Mine and on to Helenvale Falls for a swim in the jungle pool waterfalls before heading back down the mountain to the airport for your scenic flight to Cairns. (B)

### Day 3: Daintree Rainforest to Cairns

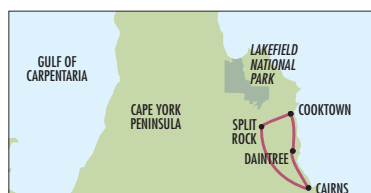
This morning an interpretive walk in the rainforest. Cross the Daintree River on the cable ferry to Daintree Village. An afternoon cruise on the Daintree River and hopefully see an Estuarine Crocodile. Return to Port Douglas or Cairns, ending your adventure. (B)

## 3 Day Cape York Turtle Rescue



### HIGHLIGHTS:

- Hands on turtle conservation
- Remote wilderness experience at Camp Chivaree
- Modern bush camping facilities

### Day 1: Weipa to Mapoon

Transfer from Weipa Airport north to the Aboriginal community of Mapoon, then by 4WD to Camp Chivaree on the banks of Janie Creek. In the afternoon travel by dinghy to Flinders Beach where the research work on the turtles takes place. Travel by 4WD up and down the 24 kilometres of beach, stopping frequently to spot turtles, watch them lay and record research data. Stay the next two nights at Camp Chivaree, Janie Creek. (D)

### Day 2: Camp Chivaree, Janie Creek

After breakfast return to Flinders Beach for more research. Look for eruptions of nests and record data of hatchlings, and then help the rangers clear the beach of any ghost nets and assist in setting Predator Exclusion Devices. Return to camp for lunch and an afternoon at leisure, optional activities include bush tucker walks or fishing in Janie Creek. In the early evening, return to Flinders Beach then return to camp. (BLD)

### Day 3: Mapoon to Weipa

This morning bid farewell to Camp Chivaree and return to Weipa where your tour ends. (B)

### Upgrade to a 4 or 6 Day Itinerary:

Extend your stay at Camp Chivaree and continue assisting with turtle research work as well as other optional activities available at the camp.
